

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on East to South aspects above 900 metres. Weaknesses will persist in recently deposited windslab, greatest accumulations of which lie on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers above 350 metres overnight and early morning then a dry day. Winds generally moderate West-North-Westerly, veering North-North-Westerly from late morning. During the day the freezing level will rise from 400 metres to 700 metres.
