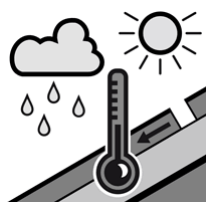


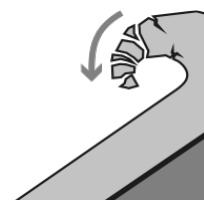

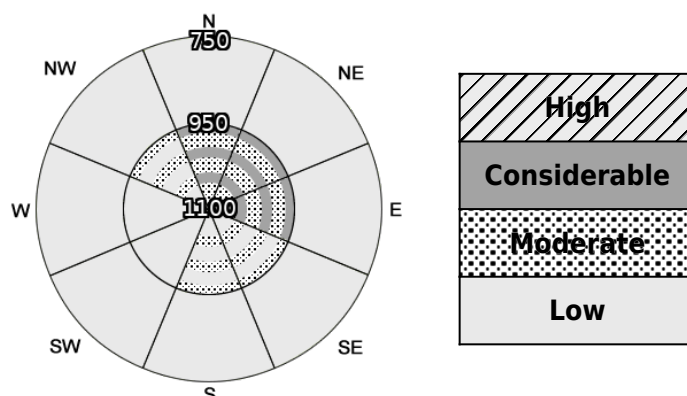

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Below 850 metres the consolidating trend will continue. At highest elevations, localised instabilities above 950 metres will persist, on primarily North to Easterly aspects. Recently formed cornices on coire back-walls of these aspects will become weak and prone to collapse with the onset of rain later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry, some rain showers will again affect the area towards end of the day. Freezing levels will stay at around summits overnight rising quickly above at the start of the day. The light South Westerly airflow will freshen steadily as the day progresses.
