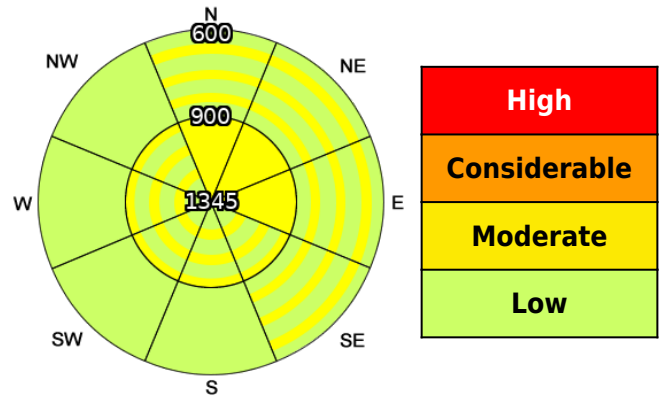

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in the mild conditions. However, wet snow instabilities will persist, these mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Some large cornices are present, and these will be prone to collapse in the mild conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be generally dry with the freezing level just above the summits. During the day the freezing level will rise to over 2000 metres, and there will be some light rain. Strong winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

Good snow cover at higher levels despite the mild temperatures. Hard going on foot.
