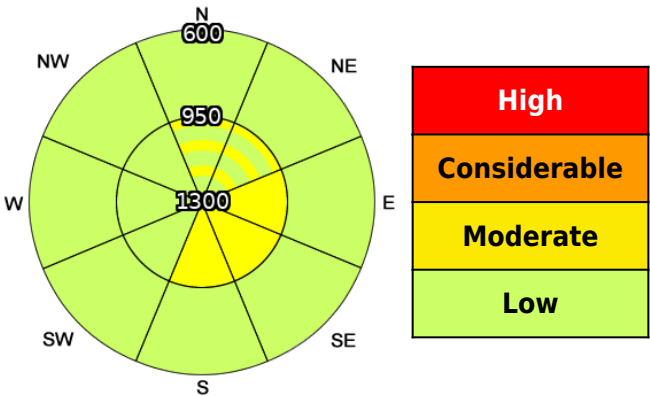

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw, it will be soft in most places but will be generally stable on all aspects below 950 metres. Surface instabilities, such as roller balls and slough avalanches are likely on all steep snow slopes, mostly above 950 metres on North through East to Southerly aspects, but especially where deepest accumulations have formed on steep Easterly aspects. Here also, any cornices will be liable to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Some rain at all levels at first, Tuesday evening. Then mostly dry throughout the forecast period. Freezing levels at summits during the night, well above the summits during the day. Overnight winds strong Westerly becoming storm force South-Westerly by the afternoon
