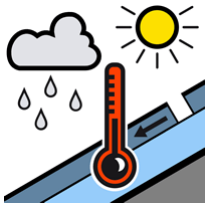


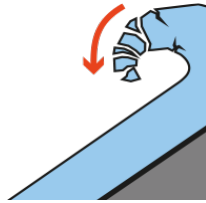

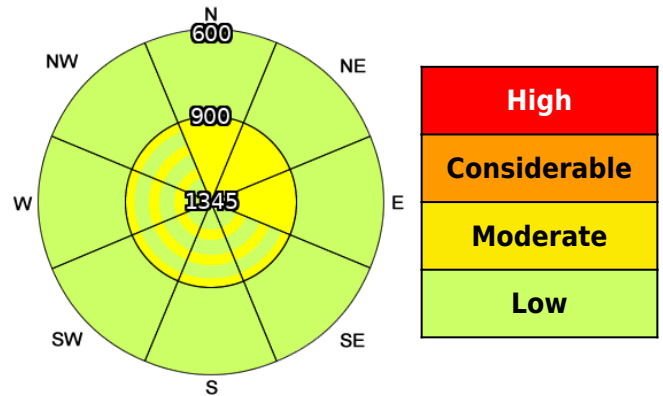
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in the mild conditions. Wet snow instabilities will persist, mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Some large cornices are present and these will be prone to collapse in the mild, wet conditions potentially triggering avalanches on the slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-West winds overnight become moderate during the day. Rain or drizzle throughout. Freezing level above the summits.
