

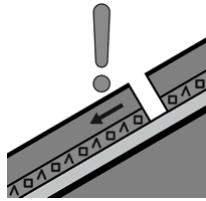

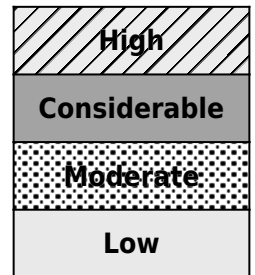
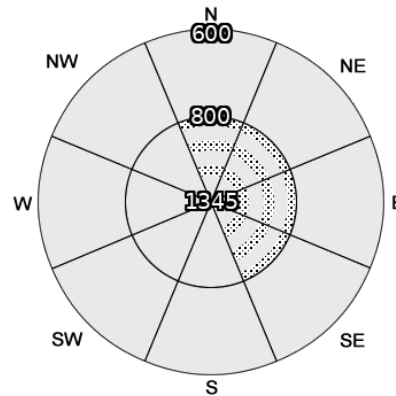
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will freeze in the colder temperatures and will be generally stable. Localised deposits of unstable windslab will accumulate mainly on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres with corrie rims and tops of gullies most affected. Fragile cornices will form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong West-South-Westerly winds. Snow showers. Freezing level around 600 metres overnight rising to 800 metres in the afternoon.
