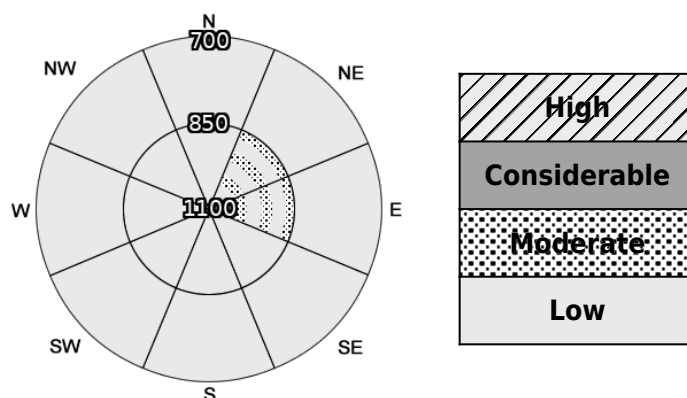

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of fresh windblown snow will begin to develop in localised areas on North-East and Easterly aspects above 850 metres. These are expected to be in very sheltered areas, particularly corrie rims and gully exits. Any new cornice development on these aspects will be fragile. The majority of the snowpack will have good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force winds, mainly Westerly in direction, becoming fresh to strong by the afternoon. Showers throughout the period falling as snow above 600 metres and slightly lower during the night.

Comments

Very stormy with wintry conditions returning over the weekend.
