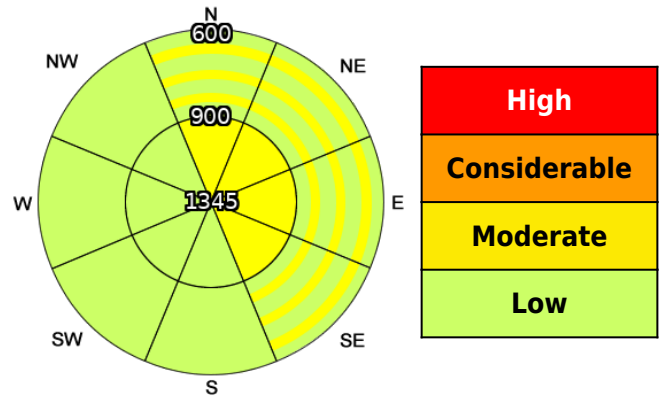
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of windslab will be deposited in sheltered locations on North through East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Although not particularly extensive or deep, these deposits will be poorly bonded. The tops of slopes and gullies will be most affected. Windward aspects will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers throughout the period. The freezing level will generally be around 800 metres. South-Westerly winds will veer to the West.

Comments

Areas of unstable snow not expected to be extensive on Sunday. However, some areas such as tops of gullies may require some caution.
