

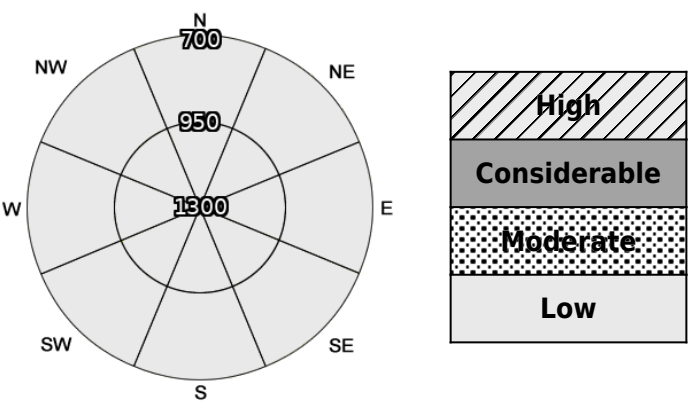

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 26/03/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any fresh snow accumulations on mostly East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres will gradually consolidate and stabilise. Elsewhere the snowpack that lies above 900 metres on Northerly to South-Easterly aspects will remain firm and stable. In other areas the ground is mostly bare and wind scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry forecast period is expected. Winds moderate strength Westerly on the tops. Freezing level around 1000 metres overnight rising to above the summits through the day.

Comments

Confined snowpack firm and icy with serious run-outs onto rocks and boulder fields.
