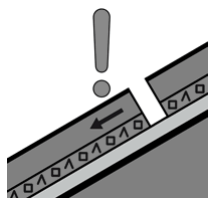


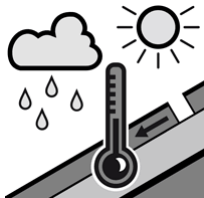

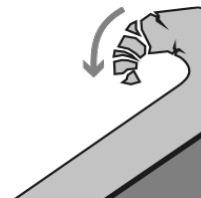

Persistent Weak Layers



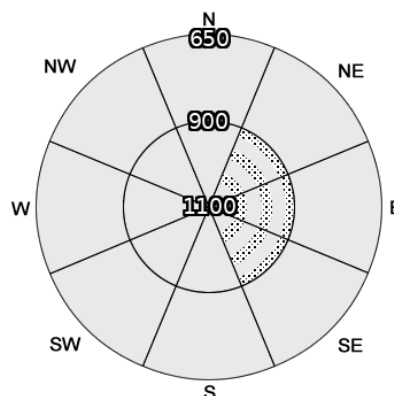

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in the windslab which lies mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. These instabilities will be generally localised and found mainly on steep slopes, in gullies and around coire rims. Cornices, mainly above these aspects, will be weak and prone to collapse. Windward slopes will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The period is expected to be mainly dry; some light showers will fall as rain at all levels during the day. The freezing level will be around 900 metres overnight and then rise above the summits. Winds will be Westerly; moderate increasing to strong overnight.

Comments

Freezing level looks as if it will stay at or above the summits for a couple of days.
