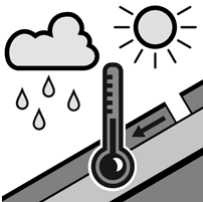


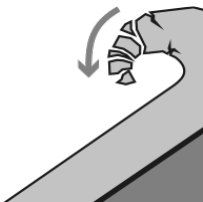

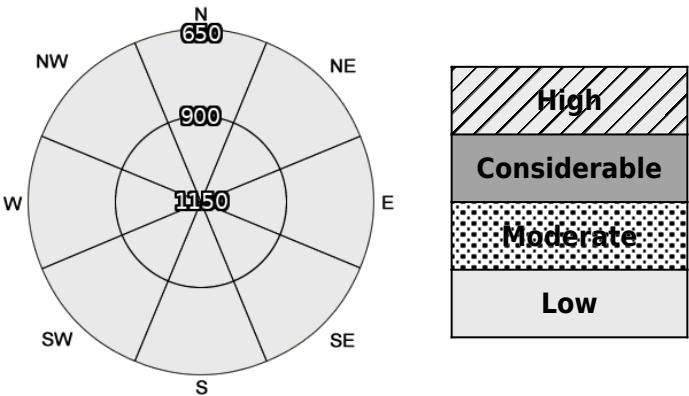
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be generally soft and moist. Some wet snow instabilities will exist on the steepest of slopes and gullies otherwise stability will be generally good. Any remaining cornices will be suspect and require caution. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become dry overnight with a return to drizzle at all levels by morning. Drizzle will affect the area throughout the day with the odd shower of rain. Winds will be mainly fresh from a West-South-Westerly direction, the freezing level will remain above the summits.
