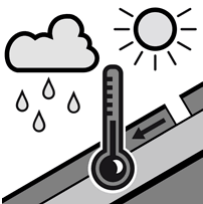


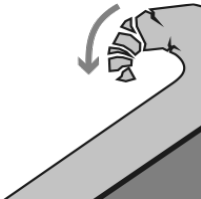

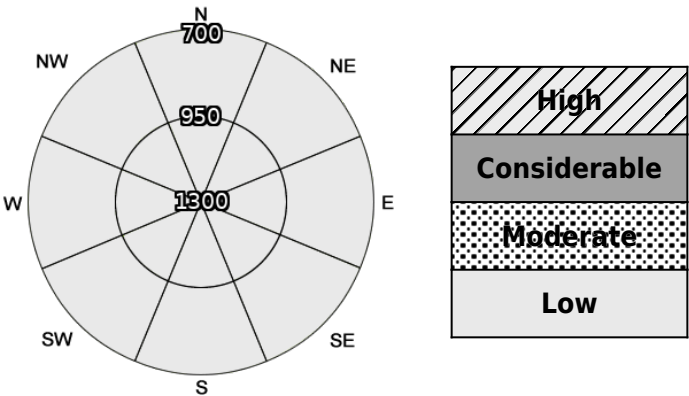

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to deplete in the mild conditions. The snowpack, very soft in the surface layers in places and firm elsewhere will be generally stable. Greatest amounts lie on mostly North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Surface instabilities such as small sloughs and roller balls are likely on the steepest, mostly Easterly facing slopes. Here also any cornice remnants may collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds will continue throughout the forecast period. Freezing levels above the summits and no precipitation is expected.

Comments

Little change expected for the next few days - cooler by the end of the week.
