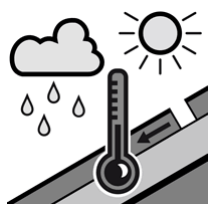


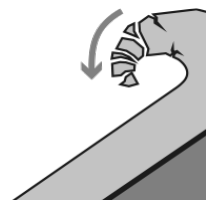

Avalanche Problems



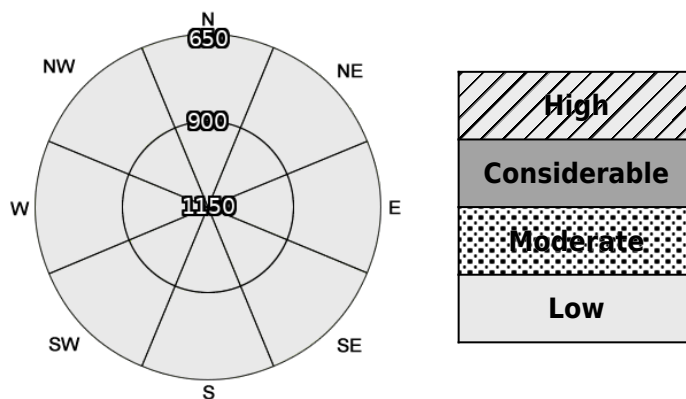
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain soft and moist at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will exist on the very steepest slopes and gullies, elsewhere stability will generally be good. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mild with freezing levels well above the summits. Rain will affect the area on Wednesday evening with a return to drier conditions overnight and through Thursday. Winds will be mainly South-Westerly fresh to strong in exposed locations.

Comments

Mild again, but becoming drier.
