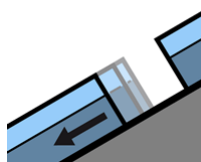

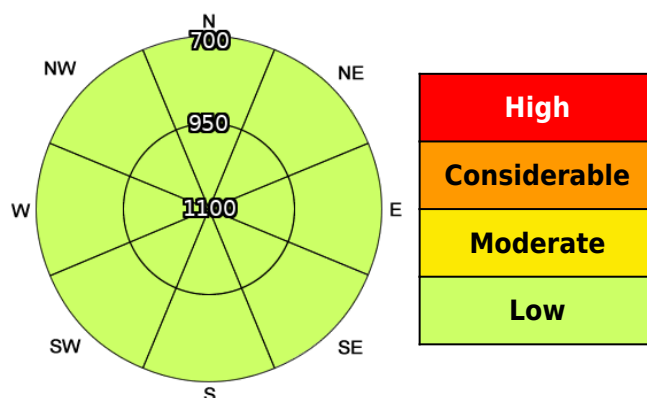

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will show better consolidation in most locations. Some very limited wet snow instability will persist on selected very steep North-East through East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Minor full depth snow slides possible from steep benches and ledges on the Post Face of Coire Ardair. Remaining old cornices will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild. Some light rain is possible very early in the period. Moderate to strong South-West winds.

Comments

Snowpack is diminishing in the thaw. Most principal gullies remain complete but with wet snow at all altitudes.
