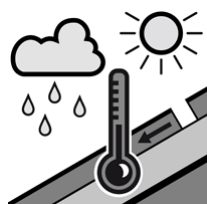


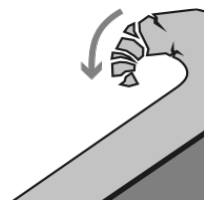

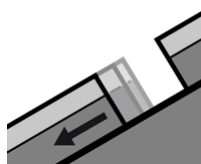

Wet Snow



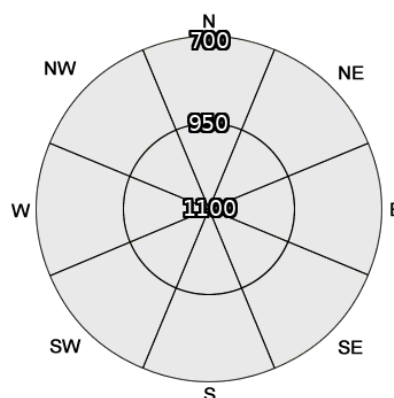
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be moist or wet but reasonably well stabilised in most locations. Minor full depth snow slides possible from steep benches and ledges on the Post Face of Coire Ardair. Remaining old cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild. Dry overnight, light rain during the day. Strong South West winds will ease a little.

Comments

Snowpack is diminishing in the thaw. Most principal gullies remain complete but with wet snow at all altitudes.
