

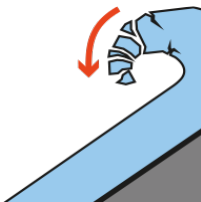

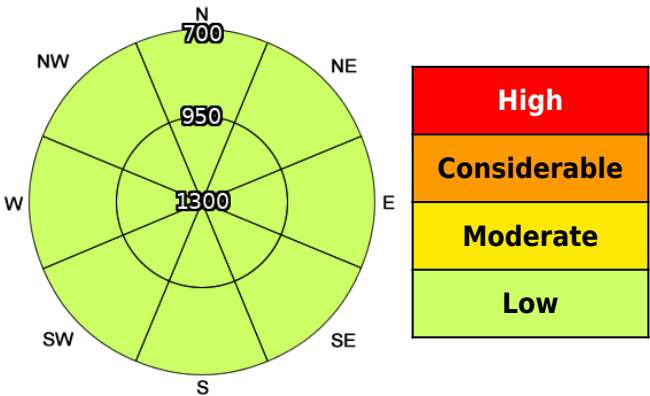

Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Surface instabilities will develop during the day on steep sun exposed slopes. Areas most affected will be around coire rims and convexities of Easterly to Southerly aspects above 950 metres. Cornices on these aspects will be unstable. Elsewhere stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions are expected throughout the forecast period. Moderate North-Westerly winds will ease through the night to become light West-South-Westerly. The freezing level will steadily rise through the day from 500 to 900 metres.
