

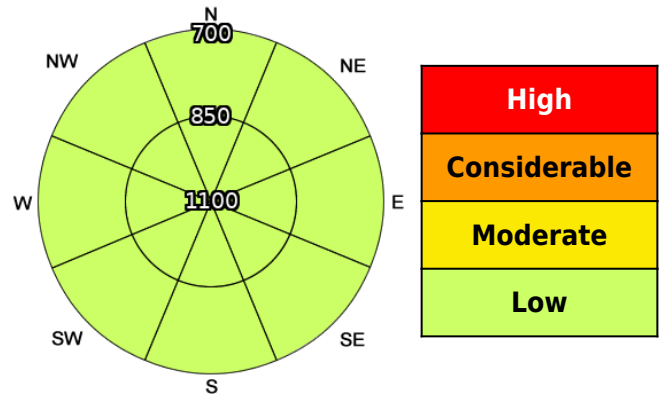

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 31/03/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable with any snow cover now limited to highest terrain above 800 metres, on mainly North to East and selected South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Building high pressure will keep the weather dry and cold. The fresh North-Westerly winds will fade overnight to be replaced by light South, then South-Westerly winds. The Freezing level will lower to around 500 metres overnight, rising slowly to around 900 metres as the day progresses.
