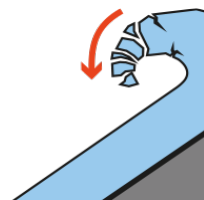

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 01/04/2019

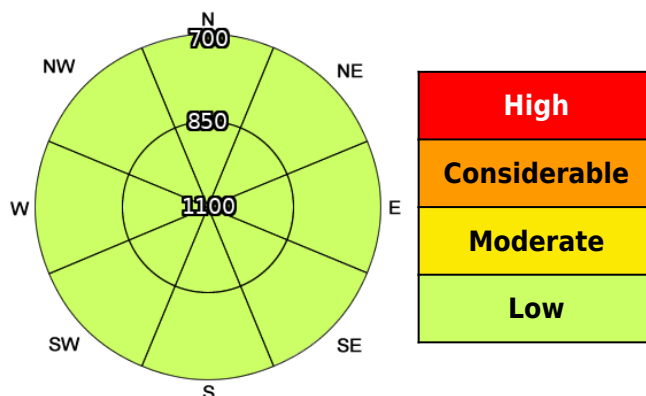
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Patchy snow cover. What remains of the snowpack will refreeze maintaining good stability in most locations. Some thin and moderately bonded windslab will begin to accumulate later in the day on steep and very sheltered North to North-East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry until late morning when light snow showers commence. Winds becoming strong Southerly. Remaining cold.

Comments

More persistent light snow setting in after midday. Thin windslab possible but only later in the day.
