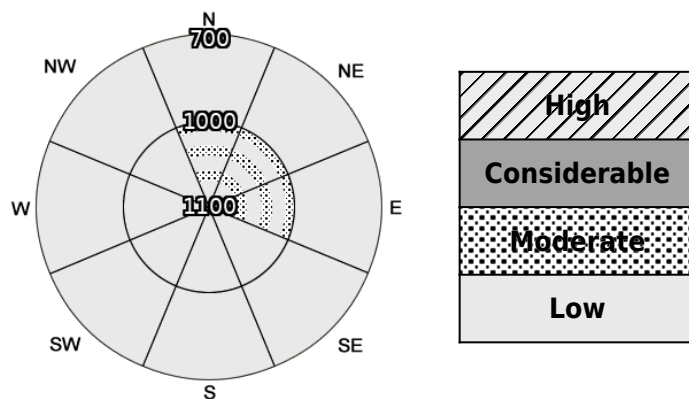
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised moderately bonded new windslab expected high on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Most affected areas will be gully exits and the top of coire backwalls. Elsewhere the exposed and patchy old snowpack will remain frozen, hard and stable. All recent windward slopes will be scoured and devoid of drifted snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming progressively colder. Overnight snow showers tapering out in the morning. Moderate to strong West- South-West or South-West winds easing to light by mid morning.
