

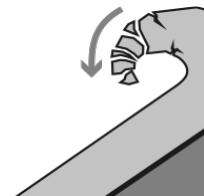

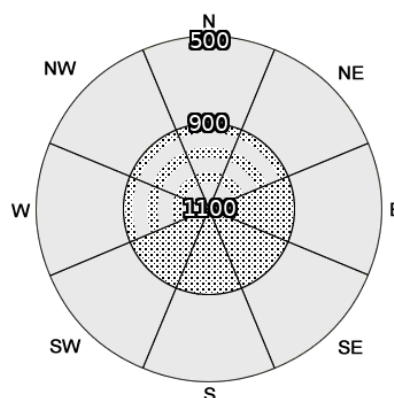
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Recent accumulations will consolidate rapidly below 750 metres, above this moderately bonded new windslab will persist in high sheltered lee locations. Most affected areas will be gully exits and the top of coire backwalls above 900 metres, on East through South to South-Westerly aspects. Any new cornice development will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some further snow showers over the period. The Freezing level will stay around 600 metres overnight rising slowly to remain below summits during the day. The winds will be strong East-North-East and Easterly.

Poor observational conditions on Wed with strong winds and fresh snow.
