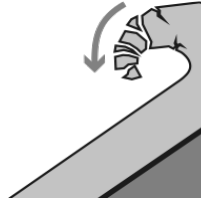

Wind Slab



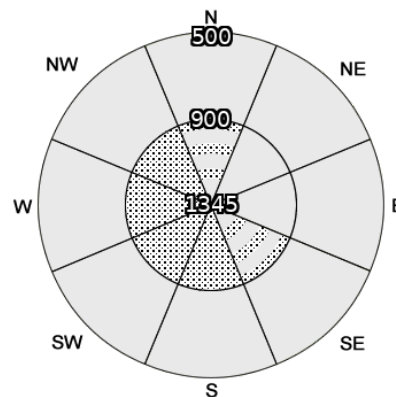

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist with greatest accumulations on South through West to North-West aspects above 900 metres. Gullies, coire rims and ridge flanks will be most affected. Redistribution will cause further windslab to build mainly on West and North-West aspects above 900 metres. Fresh cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong East-South-East winds. Mainly dry. Freezing level rising above the summits in the afternoon.
