

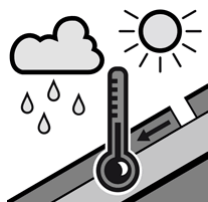

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 05/04/2019

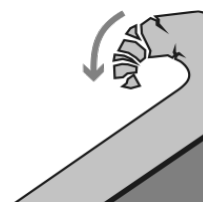
##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



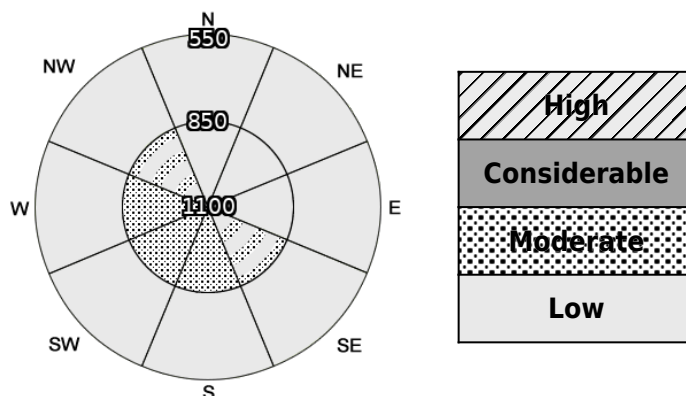
Wet Snow

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some redistribution of snow in strong winds overnight and new marginally stabilised windslab expected on steeper South-West through West to North-West aspects above 850m. Some transitional instability expected later mainly on steepest South to South West aspects above 850m when freezing level rises to summits. Consolidating expected to continue in all snow on less steep ground below 800m. Any cornices will weaken. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Strong East or East South Easterly airflow. Cold overnight but the freezing level will rise progressively to summit level by the end of the day.
