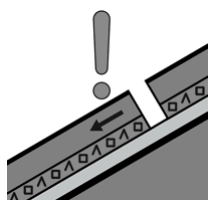


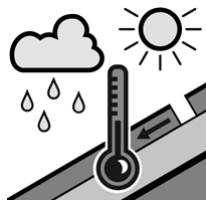

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 07/04/2019

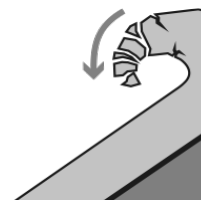

Persistent Weak Layers



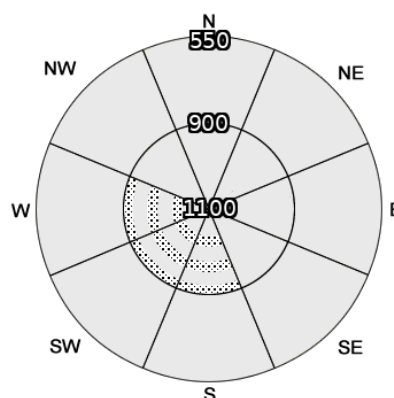

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate at all levels, and will generally be stable. However, instabilities will persist in recently deposited windslab which lies mainly on South to West aspects above 900 metres. These instabilities will be generally localised and found mainly on steep slopes, in gullies and around coire rims. Surface instabilities will be present on steep slopes. Remaining cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be above the summits. After some light rain at all levels this evening the period is expected to be dry. The wind will be moderate to strong East-North-Easterly.

Comments

The Easterly airflow is expected to continue for several days.
