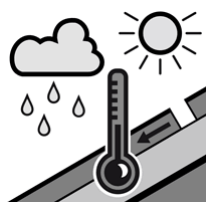


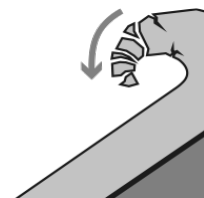

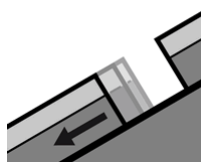

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate at all levels, and will generally be stable. Surface instabilities will be present on steep slopes, and will develop on slopes exposed to solar radiation. Minor full depth snow slides possible from steep benches and ledges on the Post Face of Coire Ardair. Any remaining cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits. It is expected to be dry, with Easterly winds, moderate overnight and easing during the day.
