

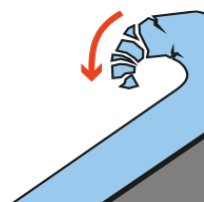

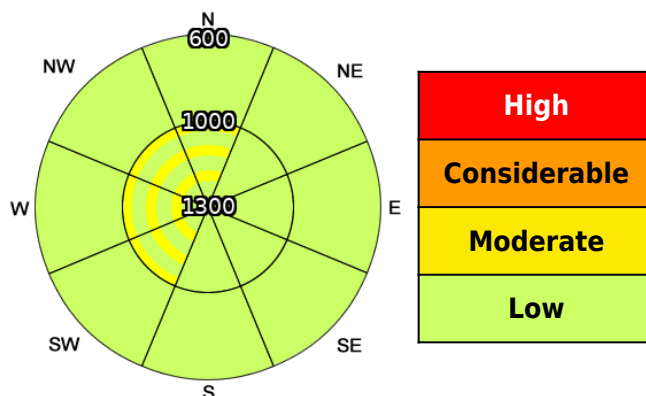

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in all locations. Surface sloughing also localised instabilities within deeper accumulations will persist on steep and convex South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 1000 metres, sun exposed slopes will be especially affected. Cornices which overhang these aspects will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate Easterly winds will ease through the night to become light during the day. Cloud will clear to leave a sunny day, freezing levels will dip to around summit levels overnight but it will be in general above the summits.
