

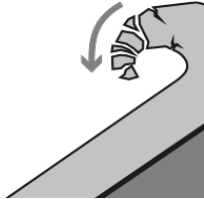

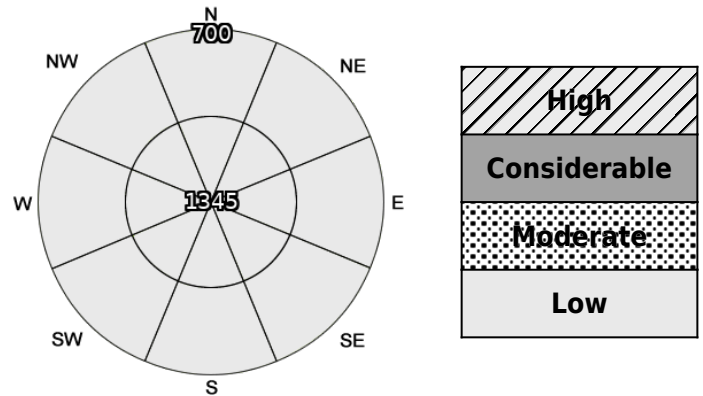
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate at all levels, and will generally be stable. Surface instabilities will be present on steep slopes, especially those exposed to solar radiation. Remaining cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain dry with the freezing level above the summits. Winds will be light East-South-Easterly.
