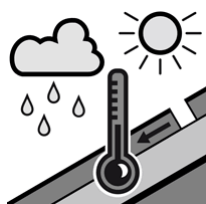


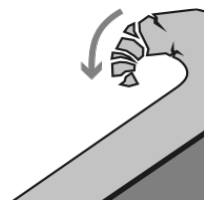

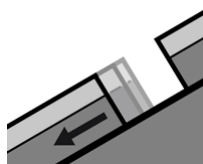

Wet Snow



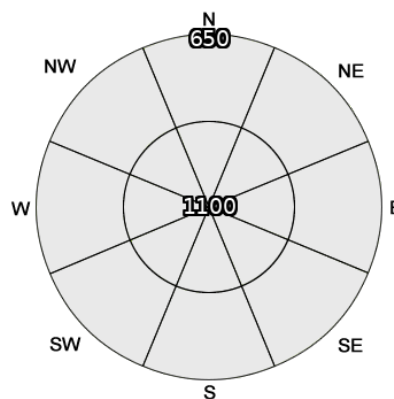
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface of the snowpack will refreeze in all locations overnight. Sun exposed slopes will soften later in the day; shaded locations will maintain a firmer snow surface. Good stability in most locations. Minor full depth snow slides possible on the Post Face of Coire Ardair later. Falling ice and rocks also a consideration as temperatures rise. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry. An overnight frost at most altitudes then sunny and warm during the day. Very light winds.
