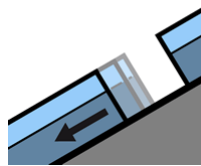

Wet Snow



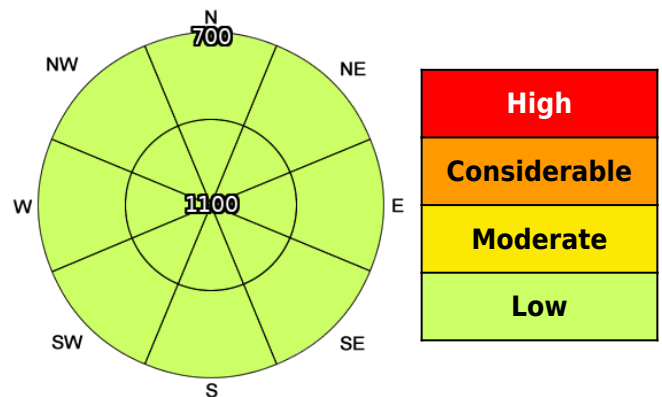

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally stable. Any new snow is expected to be insignificant. During the day snow on shaded slopes will remain firm. Some softening of the snow surface will occur where exposed to the effects of the sun. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be mainly dry, though occasional light snow flurries are possible. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres. Winds will be light mainly South-Westerly this evening, then backing and strengthening moderate South-Easterly.
