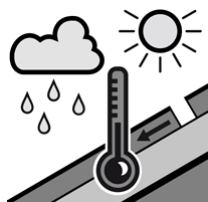


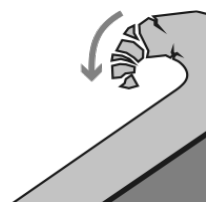

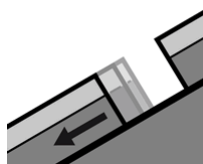
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow



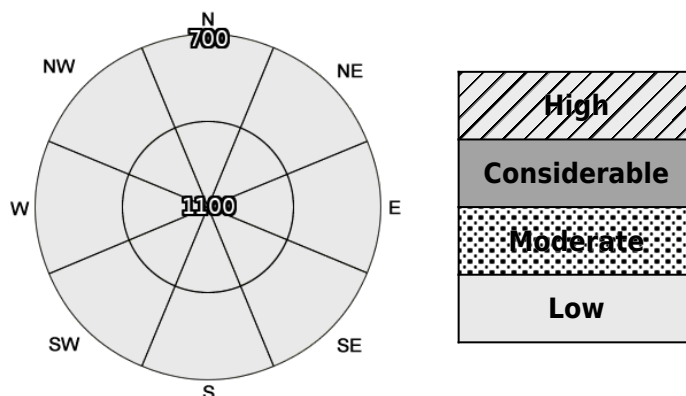
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface of the snowpack will refreeze in all locations overnight. Sun exposed slopes will soften later in the day; shaded locations will maintain a firm snow surface. Good stability in most locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry. An overnight frost at most altitudes then milder during the day. South-East winds becoming very strong later.

Comments

Wind increasing to 60mph gusts over summits later on Saturday.
