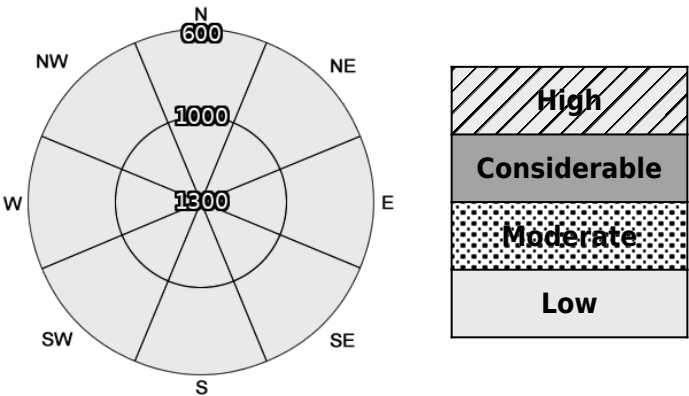
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable throughout on all aspects and at all altitudes. Shallow pockets of windslab may develop through the afternoon on West to North aspects above 900 metres. These will be isolated and generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong to gale force South-Easterly winds will continue throughout the forecast period. Dry conditions up until the afternoon when there is a possibility for some very light snow showers above 600 metres. Remaining cold with freezing levels between 600 and 800 metres.
