

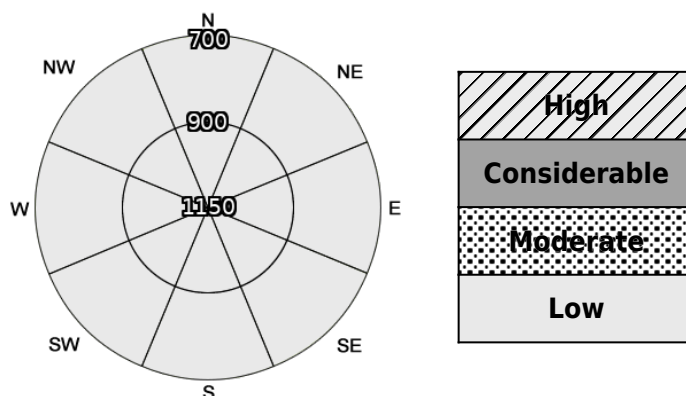

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 14/12/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a light covering of snow above 700 metres on most aspects with occasional pockets of deeper snow present in steep sheltered features mainly on East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming slightly cooler with the freezing level dropping to around 500 metres. Mostly dry with very light new snowfall forecast for the afternoon. The fresh winds will mainly be from the West-North-West but backing throughout the day to the West-South-West.

Comments

Reasonably white above 800 metres but no significant depth.
