

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 18/12/2019


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on all aspects below 800m. Marginally bonded snow will persist on steeper ground on NW through N to E aspects above 900m but generally confined to where there are deeper accumulations. Most affected areas will be coire rims and gully exits. Weak cornices in place above some of these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Quite cold throughout; freezing level around 700m rising to 900m in the afternoon. Light SW winds becoming strong SE by the end of the day.

Comments

Early rollerball activity on SE aspects from 820m this morning. Moist snow at glen level. Breaking trail away from the path less of a challenge on Tuesday but still hard work.
