

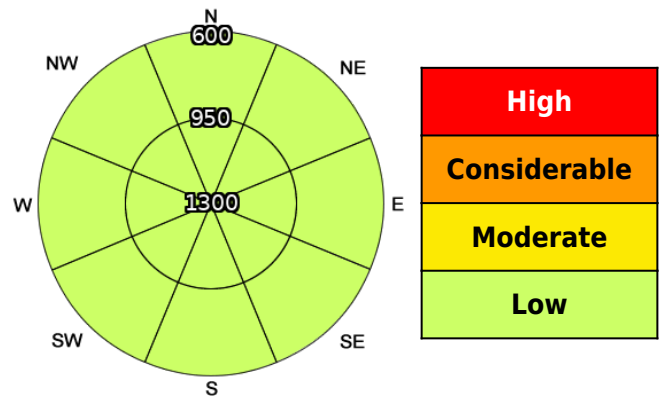

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 24/12/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected, the snowpack will be firm and stable in all areas and on all aspects. Greatest amounts lie above 900 metres on mostly North to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be moderate strength and general South-Westerly, mostly calm at lower elevations. Some very light precipitation falling as the odd snow shower overnight, lying above 800 metres.

Comments

Staying cold, a very firm snow pack, icy in places. Serious run-outs onto rocks for any trips and falls. But good, calm and wintry condition.
