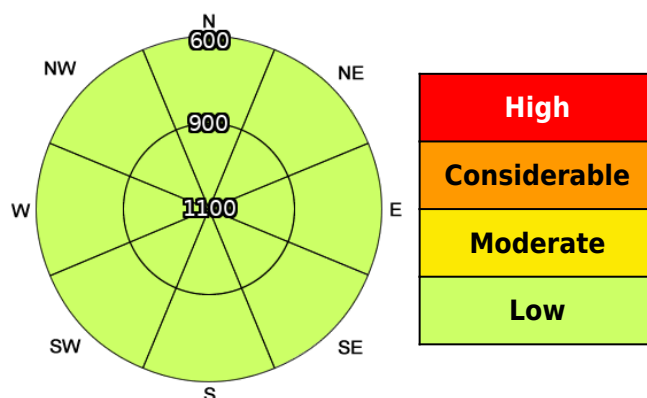
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight some fresh windslab will develop in sheltered areas, mainly on steep North to East aspects above 900 metres. These deposits are expected to be generally localised and mainly at the tops of gullies and around coire rims on these aspects. The old snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight some light snow showers are expected above about 900 metres, then a dry day. Winds will be light to moderate West-South-Westerly or South-Westerly.
