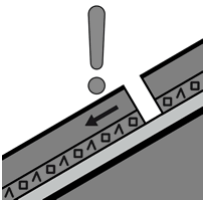


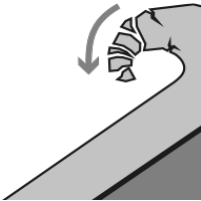

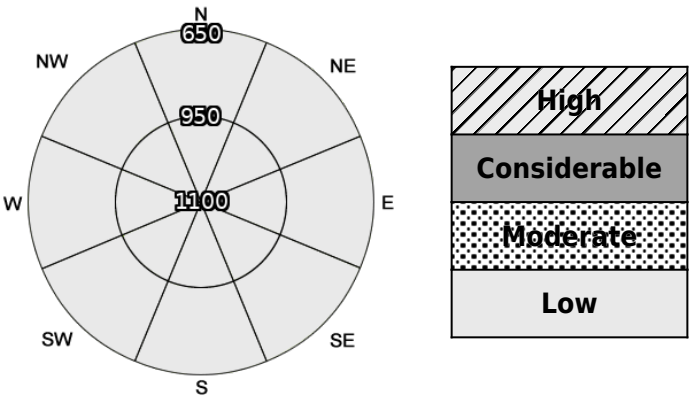
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Thawing conditions. There will be localised wet snow instabilities above 950m as the rain begins to affect all levels. Remaining cornices around coire rims above 950m on North through North East to Easterly aspects will be suspect and liable to collapse. Snow cover will become much depleted. Generally good stability in all other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to well above summits overnight, with rain developing to all levels from first light. The winds will be strong South Easterly becoming South.

Thawing at all levels. Falling ice from below steep crags an additional hazard
