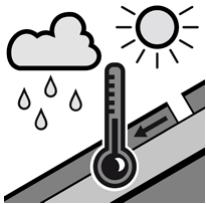


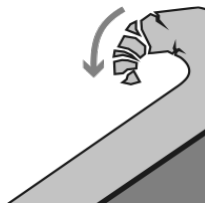

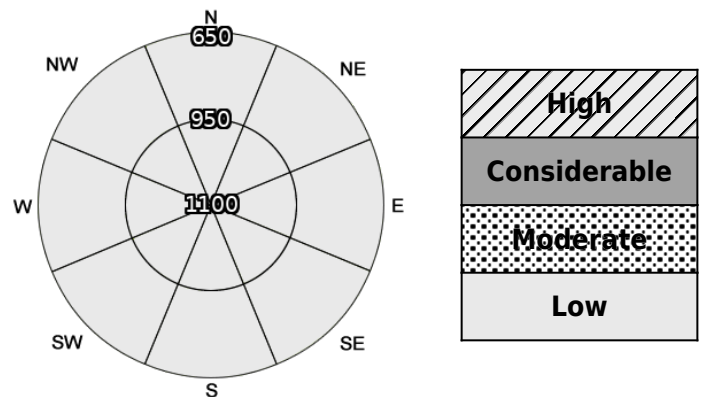
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The thaw conditions will persist. Some localised wet snow instabilities will exist above 950 metres. Any remaining cornices around the coire rims on North through North-East to Easterly aspects, although now mostly small, will be suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain well above summits, with periods of intermittent rain throughout the period. The winds will be strong generally South-Westerly.
