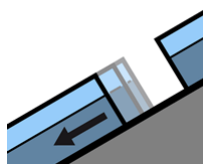

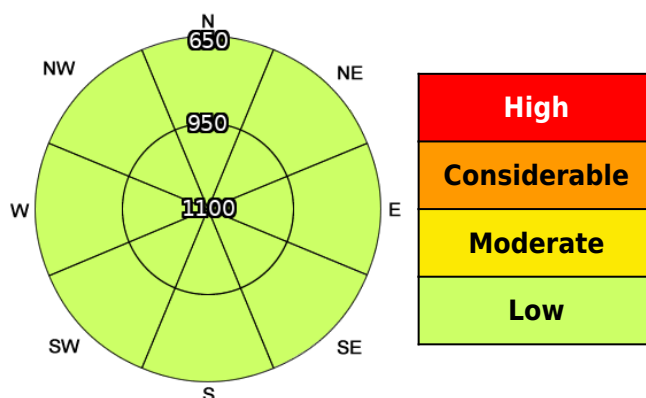

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very patchy old snowpack. Some residual wet snow instability in a few very steep N to E gullies above 750m until the onset of cooler temperatures later. Some thin localised accumulations of new windslab possible later on steep E to S aspects above 950m. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining very mild and wet overnight. Cooler from mid-morning onwards with some sleety snow over summits. WSW strong winds easing to moderate later.

Comments

Sparse snow cover on Sunday.
