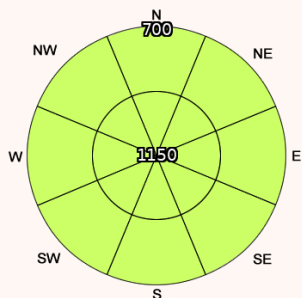


**Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Sat 04/01/2020 TO 18:00HRS Sun 05/01/2020**



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
<b>Very High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>Considerable</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
<b>Moderate</b>	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
<b>Low</b>	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mild conditions with outbreaks of rain at all levels. The freezing level will be well above the tops. Winds will be strong South-Westerly.

**Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will generally be soft and moist at all levels, surface instabilities will exist on steep scarp slopes and in sheltered summit gullies. Any remaining cornices will be suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Observed Avalanche Hazard - Sat 04/01/2020**

**Observed Weather Influences**

Milder conditions with showers of rain at all levels, winds have been fresh to strong mainly from the South-West.

**Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack initially firm is becoming soft and moist at all levels, isolated surface instabilities exist in sheltered summit gullies and corniced areas. The avalanche hazard is Low.

**Mountain Conditions**

**Observed Mountain Travel Conditions**

The moist snowpack is mainly above 800 metres in sheltered corries and gullies with a Northerly and Easterly aspect. Poor visibility later in the day above 800 metres. Winds approx 10 - 20 mph fresh, stronger on tops.

**Comments**

Snowpack firm in exposed locations but softening through the day. Mild and moist outlook. Any remaining cornices will be suspect.
