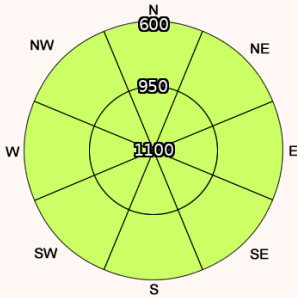


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 06/01/2020 TO 18:00HRS Tue 07/01/2020



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler overnight with a little snow over summits. Becoming suddenly milder from before dawn with heavy persistent rain at all levels. Very strong South-West winds.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Very limited snow cover. Some minor localised wet snow instability possible on some sheltered North to East aspects above 950m as snow turns to heavy rain. Otherwise the old, sparse snowpack will be wet but well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Low

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Mon 06/01/2020

Observed Weather Influences

Largely dry overnight then moderate to heavy rainfall from morning onwards. Strong South-West winds. Slightly cooler later.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Little or no new snow. The snowpack is very patchy and limited to some North to East aspects above 850m. Remnants of snow remain in a few favoured gullies at lower altitude. All remaining small snow patches are now wet but well stabilised. The avalanche hazard is Low

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Diminishing snowpack, patches above 850 metres Cloud base was at 900 metres all day. Winds approx 50 - 60 mph progress very difficult with potential to be taken off our feet
