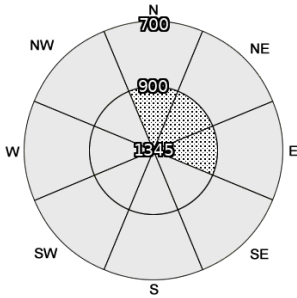


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 20/01/2020 TO 18:00HRS Tue 21/01/2020



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be mild with light precipitation falling as rain at all levels. Winds will be South-Westerly, strong overnight and generally moderate during the day.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will be present, particularly on steep slopes with recently deposited windslab, greatest accumulations of which lie mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices, which are present mainly above these aspects, will be weak and prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Mon 20/01/2020

Observed Weather Influences

It was a mainly dry day with the freezing level above the summits and strong South-West winds.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities are present and developing, particularly in the recently deposited accumulations of windslab that lie mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices are weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard is Moderate.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Variable snow, with soft moist surface, breakable crust, soft and hard windslab. Good visibility. Winds 30-40mph with stronger gusts.

Comments

It is expected to remain mild for a couple of days.
