

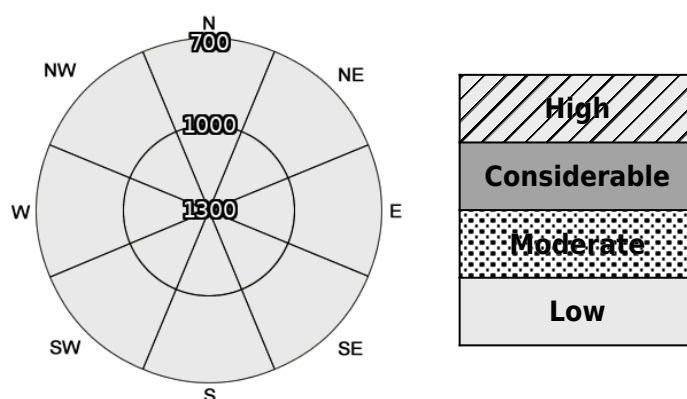

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable throughout. Greatest amounts are on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 950 metres, mainly around corrie rims and back walls. Elsewhere the ground will be mostly clear of snow with patchy areas of snow remaining on the plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the forecast period. Moderate South-South-Westerly winds will gain strength to become strong to gale force during the night and through the day. The freezing level will fluctuate around summit levels.

Comments

Turning cooler on Sunday with severe Southerly gales expected.
