

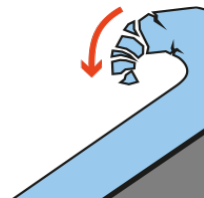

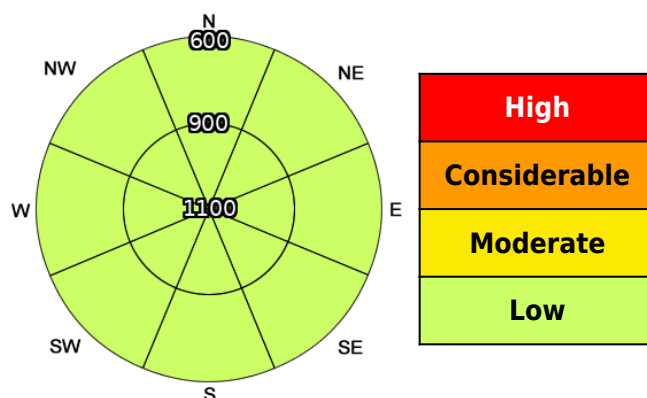
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wind-exposed snow patches will become much firmer as temperatures fall. New localised accumulations of windslab will begin to form on steeper N to E aspects above 900m from daybreak onwards. A little minor cornice development possible by the end of the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight. Precipitation falling as rain in the early hours then as snow when the freezing level falls rapidly from dawn onwards. Moderate SW winds.

Comments

More wintry flavour to the weather forecast for Sunday. Looking more wintry still overnight into Monday with snow falling to all levels.
