

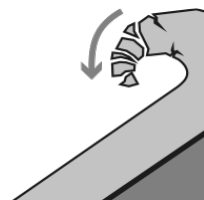

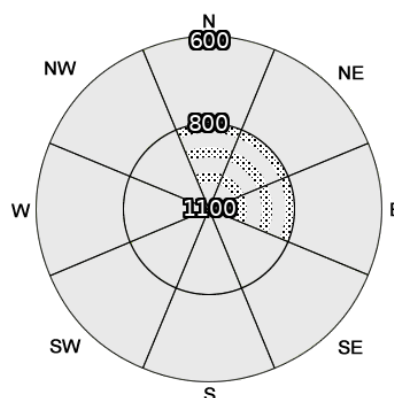
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of windslab are likely to develop as the day progresses, with localised deposits beginning to build in steeper, sheltered gully locations, on North to East aspects above 800m. Some new fragile cornices will begin to build around coire rims of these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Staying cooler than of late with further wintry showers over the period. The Freezing level will lower further 400 to 500 metres. The winds will be strong South-South-Westerly.
