

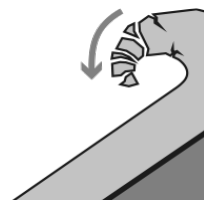

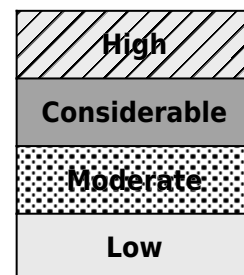
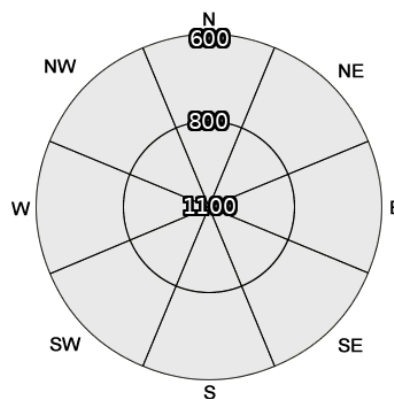
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab will start to accumulate mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800m. Accumulations are not expected to be significant. Areas mostly affected will be gullies, coire rims and flanks. Fragile cornices will start to build once again. The old snowpack will continue to consolidate as it refreezes. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-West winds overnight will then gradually veer West and North-West and decrease in strength during the day. Rain and summit snow will feature overnight before turning to snow as the freezing level drops from around midday to 700m.
