

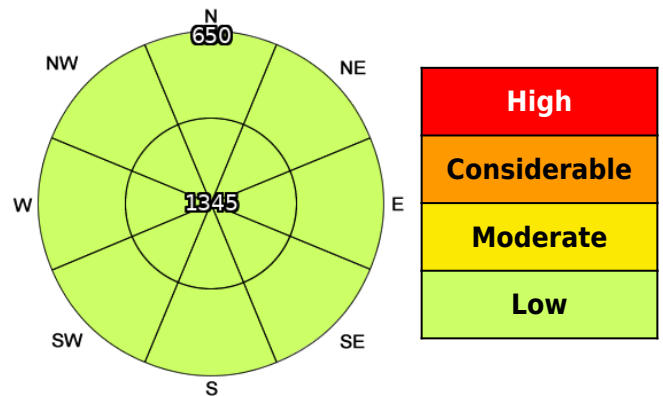

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 02/02/2020

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The wet snowpack will freeze in the colder temperatures and become stable. Fresh windslab will develop during the day, mainly on West to North aspects above 900 metres but accumulations are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate South-Westerly winds will back South-Easterly overnight and then increase during the day. Mainly dry overnight with snow showers during the day. The freezing level will be around 600 metres overnight, rising to 1000 metres in the afternoon.
