




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to develop both in depth and distribution. Corrie rims, gully exits and steep scarp slopes mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres will be particularly affected. Also South-East aspects to a lesser extent. Unstable cornices will also be found on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Initially cold overnight but the freezing level will rise to around 1000 metres during the day. Snowfall overnight but dry during the day. Very strong Westerly winds will ease and veer to the North-North-West during the day.

Comments

Older snow ice is very firm with serious run outs in most locations.
