





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will thaw and start to consolidate. Isolated wet surface instabilities are possible, particularly on steep terrain on North through East to South-East facing aspects above 900 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Otherwise the soft snow will remain stable. Recently scoured terrain will be thin and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining dry throughout the period. The freezing level will rise above the summits early morning. Strong winds, mostly West-South-West during the day.

Comments

Older snow ice will start to soften but likely to remain firm and icy with serious run outs in many locations.
