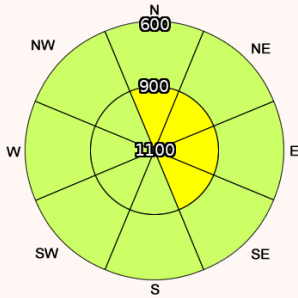


## Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Tue 04/02/2020 TO 18:00HRS Wed 05/02/2020



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
<b>Very High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>Considerable</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
<b>Moderate</b>	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
<b>Low</b>	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with strong West-South-West winds. The summit air temperature will rise to around -1C.

### Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist above 900 metres in accumulations of existing windslab which lie mainly on North through East to South-East aspects. Redistribution of snow will deposit further windslab in sheltered areas mainly on North-East and East aspects. Weak cornices will be present above North through East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

## Observed Avalanche Hazard - Tue 04/02/2020

### Observed Weather Influences

After some overnight snowfall the day was dry. The freezing level was around 900 metres. Winds were moderate North-Westerly.

### Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities are present in accumulations of recently deposited windslab, which lie mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Weak cornices are present over these aspects. Surface instabilities were noted on steep sun-exposed slopes. The avalanche hazard is Moderate.

### Mountain Conditions

#### Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Little snow below 650m. Good visibility. Winds 15-30mph.

#### Comments

A more settled couple of days appear to be in prospect.
