



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 07/02/2020

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The limited snowpack will remain well consolidated and stable throughout. A surface crust will form overnight and remain in shaded areas during the day. Otherwise, the snow will soften in the sun and will be firmer at higher elevations. Most snow remains above 750 metres on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day is forecast, generally clear with sunny spells, although partly cloudy at times. Expect strong Southerly winds during the day. The freezing level will remain above the summits, although the air temperature will drop to -1C at 1000 metres during the afternoon.

Comments

A good day to be out in the hills tomorrow, although it will feel cold in strengthening winds.
