

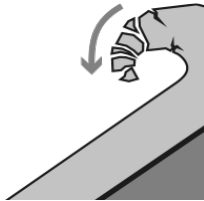

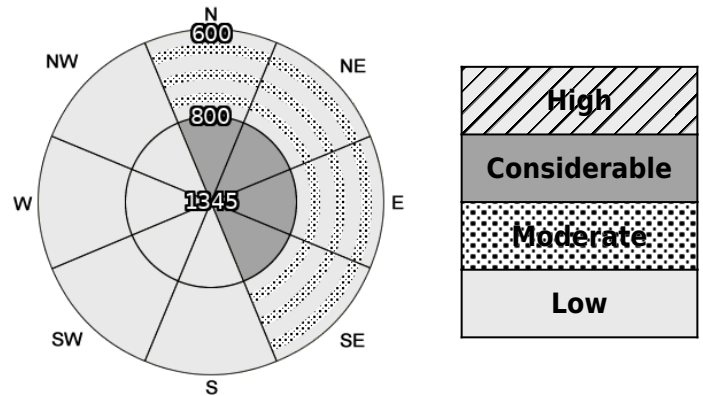
Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in wind sheltered areas onto existing deep accumulations. Greatest deposits will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will continue to build above these aspects. Other wind-sheltered locations will also be affected due to cross loading. Slopes exposed to the strong winds will generally be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Winds will be strong Westerly overnight; West-South-Westerly through the day, and easing during the afternoon. Snow shower are expected throughout the forecast period, heaviest overnight. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.
